Terms and Conditions of Entry

Acceptable Works

This art sale is open to all financial members and teachers of Malvern Artists' Society (MAS). Artists may submit up to 10 works. Works may be hangable or unhangable. Works may be 2D or 3D, but diptychs and triptychs cannot be entered.

Works must not pose a work, health or safety risk or any other risk to people or property. Wet or unfinished works will not be accepted. Works must be the artist's original work and must not infringe copyright, moral or other rights.

Entry and Delivery and Collection

The works must be delivered with a completed entry form to MAS on 24 February 2026. Receiving hours for artwork will only be between 10am to 2pm. Works must be numbered and labelled with the Artist's Name and Price. Works must be for sale and cost \$300 maximum. No commission will be taken.

Artists must pay a fee of \$15 no matter how many works are entered. This fee is non-refundable unless the exhibition is cancelled. Artists may pay either online with a credit card, in person (cash/credit card), or by electronic funds transfer (EFT) to:

Works to be hung must be suitably framed (except 3D). Works on stretch canvas with painted sides will be considered framed. These works must be fitted with flat screws or D-rings and wire for hanging (or similar). Metal frames and stapled fixings are not permitted.

Works intended not to be hung must be presented in a neat and tidy way. Mounts and cellophane are recommended for watercolours. 3D works must be freestanding with a stable base.

Unsold works must be collected on 4 March 2026 between 10am to 2pm. MAS may dispose of a work that remains uncollected after a reasonable time.

Disclaimers

This exhibition will be held at the discretion of MAS. Works will be displayed at the discretion of MAS, and in the manner decided by MAS. All care will be taken when handling works, however MAS will not be responsible for any loss, theft, or damage.

Artists grant MAS the right to create and reproduce images of themselves and/or their works in whole or part by any means and in any media for archival, promotional, or other purposes.
